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The Roundwood & District Community Council have received grant funding from Wicklow Co Council for the reinstatement of paths at the Vartry Reservoirs. Some work has been carried out on the Lower Vartry Reservoir. This involves the establishment of a compound area at Point A and the development of approximately 1km of trail from A to B to the west of Upper Vartry Reservoir at Knockraheen as outlined on the map below. You are invited to tender for the work as described in the specification below. It is advisable that you arrange a site visit.



Specification of Work

The Vartry Reservoirs are an environmentally sensitive area due to its use as a source of water for North Wicklow and South Dublin and its designation as a proposed Natural Heritage Area. All work shall be carried out in an environmentally sensitive manner to ensure no contamination of water or unnecessary destruction of sensitive habitat.

- Compound area (2500m2) should be stripped back and dressed with 300mm deep of hardcore
- Supply & fit entrance gates to accommodate a 5m wide splayed entrance to accommodate optimum sightlines. Gate shall be set back 5m and parallel to road
- The trail, in general should be stripped back and dressed to 1200mm wide X 200 deep
- All topsoil & debris to be spread/disposed in a visually unobtrusive manner on site or used for cut and fill areas (common sense approach)
- Stone will be supplied by Roundwood & District Community Council to compound area and delivered as required
- Spread stone to agreed levels
